Dear Family Member:

As many of you know, The Glen community, including residents and staff, have now received the second Moderna vaccine. We are delighted that all residents that qualified were vaccinated, and many of the staff and contractors agreed to receive the vaccine voluntarily.

As such, by Friday, March 12, our community will experience the highest level of protection against COVID-19 since this pandemic began. We are extremely excited about this as we have endured a year of restrictions and uncertainty in our lives.

The good news is that we have been working on a phased plan to begin easing our COVID restrictions for visitation to residents in The Cottages.

In our first phase beginning on Monday March 15, visitation will be allowed in resident apartments on Monday through Sunday from 9:00a.m.– 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. through 4:00 p.m. by appointment only.

We must continue to protect each other by following the guidelines set below.

- a. 2 adults may visit a resident by appointment only
- b. Visits may last up to 2 hours
- c. You may still utilize the sunroom if preferred or outdoors if weather permits
- d. Screening and hand sanitizer use will continue upon entrance to the building
- e. Mask will be worn at all times during visit
- f. Visitors will only be allowed in resident apartment; not in common areas
- g. No food or drinks will be allowed

It is also important that we all keep in mind that at any time during this phase, circumstances may change. We will keep you updated along the way.

We are grateful to our families who have provided such support to our staff through this past year. We look forward to moving in a positive direction and continuing our mission to enrich the lives and provide a safe and healthy environment for our residents.
